Did you know...

When you are in the Guardian/Child drop down menu, you can just type the first letter of the last name and the list will pop down to them quickly. In fact, if you type the first two letters of the last name quickly, it will get even closer.

When looking up a child or guardian, click on the small, blue magnifying glass next to the drop down menu. Type in the name and find the guardian or child no matter what status they have (Active, Exited, Wait list, etc.). You can also search by phone number!

When you are on that Welcome screen, you can click on the Guardian's name under "Upcoming Private Contacts" and you will be taken directly to the Contact History of that guardian.

Visit Tracker Web Screening Re-Design

By now, many of you have seen the new Screening re-design. This re-design was inspired by two things:

1. The need to specifically track the number of children receiving the ASQ-3, ASQ-SE and the OAE for the PAT National Center year end report.
2. Requests from educators to have a place in Visit Tracker to enter screening scores.

Here are a few common questions that have come up:

1. To record both the ASQ-3 and ASQ-SE, you will need to enter each screening as a "New Screening" (even if the ASQ-3 and ASQ-SE dates are the same). Enter both under the development section of the screening and you can enter the scores for each screening tool (SE scores can be accumulated and entered under Social Emotional). Be sure to save at the bottom of the screen.
2. The referral information has been moved to the bottom of the Screening Summary form, so all screening information is located in one convenient place, on one form.

Updates made to the Guardian Demographics Page

Another big change that has been made to Visit Tracker Web, is the Demographics page and the High Needs indicators. You will now notice two sections (and in Missouri, three) that very clearly state the PAT National Center definitions. A family must have at least TWO of the National high needs indicators checked to have the family be called a "high needs" family for National reports (as of 2012). National Center for Parents As Teachers has definitions for each of the High Needs Demographics categories. Questions concerning definitions and who qualifies should be directed to National Center.
