
Did you know....

When you are working and have open PVR, save and close it when you are finished. It is important to only have one PVR open at a time. Do not minimize it and open another PVR. When you have multiple PVR's open, it may not save the most recent information that you have entered. It may also see the minimized PVR as "idle" and "idle" screens will cause your Visit Tracker Web to "timeout" and you may get told to save or get kicked out.

If you are wanting a Group Connection to count on your end of year report, you must enter that Group Connection on the Calendar as a "Group". If the group is entered as a "Play Group" or "Event", these do not count as a Group Connection.

When entering a "Group", and if you choose "Public", all educators will see it on their calendars. This also means that any educator can delete the group. Never delete something without checking with your administrator or other educators.

Child Main Data Page

Educators can now track caregiver relation. Enter if the child is a biological child, step child, etc.

Child Health Info

The new Health Info Screen can be found by clicking on "Health Info" on the left hand side when in a child file. On this new Health Info Screen, educators can now track the Medicaid #, Due Date, and information concerning if the child had a delay at enrollment. There is also a section for the child's insurance history, and the medical visit history. The Due Date will from now on be entered at enrollment and when the DOB is changed, this Due Date field will remain the original date you entered.

Guardian Demographic Screen

On the Guardian demographic page, educators can now enter the Primary Parent DOB, Social Security Number and Gender. There is also an area to document Family Income History, Primary Parent Employment History, and Primary Parent Education History.

*Please note: the previously existing
"Education level" and "Yearly Family
Income field" which you may have been
using will disappear in the future, you should
enter that information in the new History
fields for that data so that changes over time
can be better tracked.

Guardian Health Info

The new Health Info Screen can be found by clicking on "Health Info" on the left hand side when in a Guardian file. Educators can now track the Medicaid #, the Insurance History, the tobacco use survey, and the medical visit history.

*Please note: you will only see the "medical visit history" on the new Health Info Screen if your program administrator has gone into SETUP and down to PREFERENCES and answered Yes to the question "Does your agency record dates of medical visits?"
